January Boxtop & Campbell Labels Results

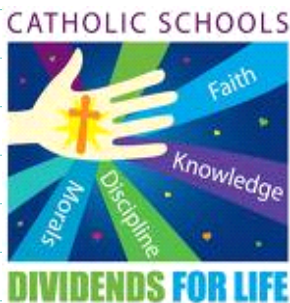
Third grade collected the most Campbell labels - 1290 points
